

# Behavior Contract

## Photography and Developing Students

The contract is intended to outline and remind Photography and Developing Students of the behavioral expectations that Mr. Langley has of them. Safety in the classroom is a concern, as students will be using chemicals to process negatives and prints and will be using photographic equipment in a studio setting. Because of the environment of the classroom, students will be held to a more strict discipline policy. Mr. Langley has reviewed the following list of expectations with Photography and Developing Students.

1. Each student is expected to adhere to the Darkroom/Classroom Guidelines at all times.
2. Each student understands that horseplay and wrestling are not permitted in the darkroom or in the classroom.
3. Each student understands the safety concerns regarding the chemicals and equipment used in this class and will use them properly.
4. Any student given three referrals for failing to follow the Darkroom/Classroom Guidelines, irresponsible behavior regarding the darkroom, damage to photography equipment, or for improper use of chemicals will be removed from the class for the remainder of the year and will receive no credit for the time missed.
5. Any student who has credit removed will be entitled to a review of the disciplinary matters in question.
